Recently in a WIB webinar, RLR discussed the almost 43 million detected cybersecurity incidents during the past year, a 48 percent increase over 2013. Regulators are gearing up and conducting cybersecurity assessments of institutions that will be performed during the regularly scheduled examination. This assessment is part of a Federal Financial Institutions



Examination Council (FFIEC) initiative to determine a financial institutions maturity level for managing and mitigating cyber threats. 10 QUESTIONS FOR EXECUTIVES AND THEIR BOARDS

- 1. Is cyber risk part of our current risk management framework?
- 2. Do we follow the NIST Cybersecurity Framework?
- 3. Do we know the cyber risks that our vendors and third-party service providers expose us to, and do we know the rigor of their cybersecurity controls?
- 4. Do we have cyber risk insurance? And if we do, what does it cover and exclude? Is our coverage adequate based on our cyber risk exposure? While the cyber insurance market is relatively new, it is growing.
- 5. Do we engage in basic cyber hygiene?
- 6. Do we share incident information with industry groups? If so, when and how does this occur?
- 7. Do we have a cyber-incident playbook and who is the point person for managing response and recovery?
- 8. What roles do senior leaders and the board play in managing and overseeing the cyber incident response?
- 9. When and how do we engage with law enforcement after a breach?
- 10. After a cyber-incident, when and how do we inform our customers, investors, and the general public?

FIL 9-2015 - FFIEC BCP Examination Handbook Appendix J Strengthening the Resilience of Outsourced Technology Services Dated February 23, 2015_Effective for all FFIEC Supervised Institutions

The Federal Financial Institutions Examination Council (FFIEC) has issued an appendix to the Business Continuity Planning (BCP) booklet of the *FFIEC Information Technology Examination Handbook* entitled "Strengthening the Resilience of Outsourced Technology Services." The booklet is part of the IT Examination Handbook series and provides guidance to assist examiners in evaluating the risk management processes of financial institutions and service providers to ensure the availability of critical financial services.

Appendix J discusses the following four key elements of BCP that an FI should address to ensure that their technology service providers (TSPs) are providing resilient technology services:

- Third-Party Management
- Third-Party Capacity

- Testing with Third-Party TSPs
- Cyber Resilience
